PCARA Meeting Minutes

February 7, 2026, Putnam Valley Library

Meeting: called to order by Robert, N2CBH

Secretary's Report: Lou KD2ITZ introduced John Thompson to the group. John is a new club member and is studying for his amateur radio licensing exams. He already holds a GMRS callsign WSIV540. All attendees took turns sharing a few things about themselves.

Lou reported that there have been two VE test sessions since the last club meeting. A test session was held on the campus of Lakeland High School on January 15, 2026. Three of the four students qualified for Technician licenses. An additional test session was held on Saturday January 17 at Putnam Valley Library and a high school student from Neversink, NY qualified for Technician. Lou mentioned that there were no candidates scheduled for today's VE test session.

Lou also discussed that he and Jasper NK2Y had a meeting with one of the new members of the BOCES regional safety staff. The BOCES facilities director may be amenable to locating an amateur repeater on campus, but there may be costs associated with building out a space for the equipment.

Treasurer's Report: David KD2EVI presented the report.

Infrastructure Engineering: Robert N2CBH reported that all club repeaters are operational. He mentioned that there are no audible courtesy tones when using this equipment. A discussion was held about deploying standby repeaters and automatic switching devices for activating secondary transceivers during times of failure.

Director's Report: Robert AD2CT mentioned that he will be attending the Orlando HamCation®. He plans to post video footage of the event to the PCARA YouTube channel. 
Join the roundtable to find out what members have been doing or join the Old Goats with net control Karl N2KZ for news and neighborly information.

Spring forward

Daylight saving time begins at 2:00 a.m. local time on Sunday morning, March 8th 2026. Clocks should be moved forward by 1 hour to 3:00 a.m. local time.

In the United Kingdom, clocks go forward on Sunday March 29th 2026. As a result, there are three weeks in March when USA Eastern Time and U.K. Time are only 4 hours apart instead of the usual 5 hours.
